

## TORGIANO AND DERUTA: A LAND OF FINE WINES AND HANDCRAFTED CERAMICS

**Starting and finishing point:** Torgiano

**Distance:** 27.5 km.

**Total ascent:** 250 metres

**Grade:** easy

**Road surface:** asphalt, gravel

**Recommended type of bike:** hybrid or MTB

**Places to visit in the area:** Torgiano, Deruta, the Tiber and Chiascio Natural Park

- KM 0 Start from the *Baglioni Tower*, just a short distance from the town centre. Cycle out of the town and down the hill in the direction of **Deruta** and **Bettona**.
- KM 0.5 At the traffic lights, turn **right** towards **Bettona, Deruta and Bevagna**.
- KM 1.5 Past the bridge over the River Chiascio, turn **right** in the direction of **Deruta**.
- KM 3.5 **Pontenuovo:** at the junction, go **straight across** towards **Deruta**.
- KM 6.5 **Deruta.** Having cycled out of the lower section of the town, follow the signs to **Casalina** and then ride up a short 200m. climb.
- KM 11 **Casalina:** at the junction, turn **right** and follow the signs to **Papiano**.
- KM 13.5 Turn **right** towards **Papiano Station**. Just before the level crossing leading back onto the main road, turn **right** onto the minor road running alongside the railway track.
- KM 14.8 Start of gravel road. Carry **straight on** alongside the railway line.
- KM 15.6 End of gravel road. At the junction with the surfaced road, take the **second right**, a narrow lane with fields either side.
- KM 16.8 Carry on, keeping to your **right**.
- KM 17.6 At the junction with the SP377, turn **left** into the village of **Fanciullata**. At the next junction turn **right** towards **Perugia**.
- KM 18.7 Keep to the **right-hand** lane.
- KM 20.4 At the junction with the SP375, turn **right** and then ride straight on until you get to **San Martino in Campo**.
- KM 23.5 **San Martino in Campo:** at the roundabout, turn **right** towards **Torgiano**.
- KM 25.3 Once you have crossed the bridge over the E45 Trunk Road, keep to the **right** in the direction of **Torgiano**.
- KM 26.5 **Cantine Lungarotti** (Winery): beginning of the climb up to **Torgiano**.
- KM 27.5 End of climb: turn **right** and return to the starting point.
